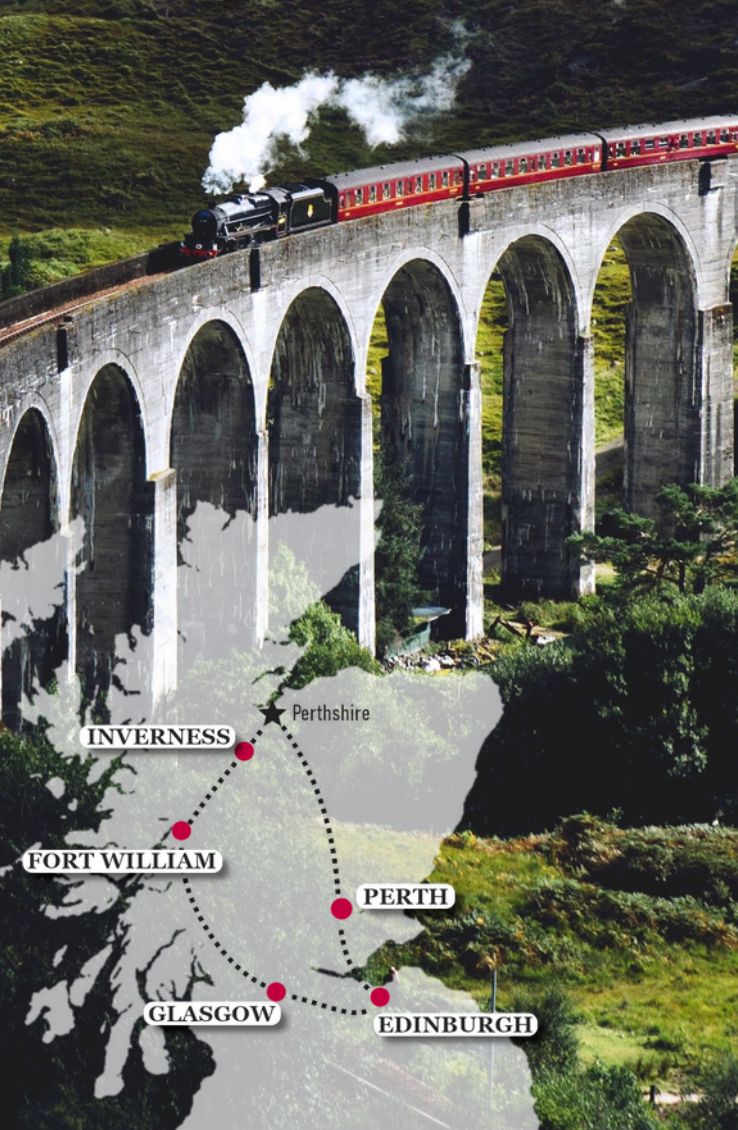


# CLASSIC SCOTLAND

## Self Guided Holiday



### Day 1 GLASGOW TO FORT WILLIAM

Drive from Glasgow north to Fort William, passing through dramatic landscapes used as backdrops in many Harry Potter films.



### Day 2 THE JACOBITE STEAM TRAIN (FORT WILLIAM)

Take a trip on the Hogwarts Express (known as the Jacobite Steam Train) which travels over the famous Glenfinnan viaduct towards the coastal town of Mallaig.

Mallaig was founded in the 1840's and is today is a busy fishing port and ferry terminal with services to Skye and the Small Isles. Arriving in Mallaig by the train service you have over an hour and a half to enjoy a walk round and take in the atmosphere: there are shops, bars, restaurants and plenty of fish and chips to be enjoyed.



### Day 3 FORT WILLIAM TO LOCH NESS & INVERNESS

Travel north to the Inverness area and stop at Urquhart Castle located on the banks of Loch Ness and look for Nessie, the illusive monster.

Loch Ness and Inverness, is a hub of activity for adventure-seekers all year round, offering many amazing outdoor activities. From walking, fishing and kayaking, to golfing, mountain biking and paragliding, there is a multitude of wonderful things to do - all set against the breath-taking backdrop of the stunning Scottish Highlands.



### Day 4 INVERNESS

Spend the day at leisure exploring the highlands or visiting local attractions. You could visit Culloden Manor, where the last battle on British soil was fought or visit Cawdor Castle which dates back to the 14th century and is the castle linked to Shakespeare's 'Macbeth'.



### Day 5 INVERNESS TO PERTSHIRE

On route to Perthshire explore the impressive Cairngorm Mountains and visit Aviemore Wildlife Safari Park, Blair Castle and the House of Bruar.

Known as the 'Big Tree Country', in Perthshire you are never far from a remarkable tree, whether that happens to be oldest living thing in Europe, the last descendant of Shakespeare's Birnam Wood or the widest conifer in Britain.



### Day 6 PERTSHIRE TO EDINBURGH

Visit Perth, beautifully situated on the River Tay before arriving in Edinburgh, Scotland's capital. Stroll down picturesque and vibrant Victoria Street or walk through the cobbled streets of the medieval Old Town, from Edinburgh Castle to the Palace of Holyroodhouse.

Steeped in history, Edinburgh seamlessly blends old and new, providing locals with the perfect destination to experience the sights, sounds and tastes of a diverse and vibrant city.



### Day 7 ALNICK CASTLE

Visit Alnwick Castle which was featured as Hogwarts in the first two Harry Potter movies before you return to Edinburgh.



### Day 8 DEPART GLASGOW

Enjoy the time you have left in Glasgow before you drive to the airport to return your car in time for your return flight.
